Architectural Review Submittal Information

Updated April 2024



Per the Community Rules and Regulations, each and every proposed exterior modification/addition to homes or lots requires prior approval of the Architectural Review Committee (ARC).

Modifications / Additions NOT requiring approval of the ARC:

- 1. General shrub or flower plantings (unless part of a major landscaping project)
- 2. Irrigation systems

For all other modifications / additions, the process is as follows:

- The applicant / homeowner shall obtain the Architectural Approval Form (BethesdaOaks.com) or contact Property Matters Realty (PMR) via Idyer@propertymattersrealty.com or 704-861-0833 to obtain the form.
- 2. The applicant completes the form and provides all necessary documentation as requested on the form and submits all paperwork to PMR. The paperwork can be submitted via email or postal-mail to PMR. Any documents mailed shall be sent to:

- 3. PMR will review the submission for completeness and verify that all necessary paperwork has been provided by the applicant.
- 4. Once PMR has confirmed that all necessary paperwork has been provided, they will email the submission to the ARC for review in accordance with the Community Rules and Regulations.
- 5. PMR emails reviewed submissions with all submitted paperwork to ARC for their review.
- 6. The ARC will review the submission and provide their response to PMR via email.
- 7. PMR will then notify the applicant of approval or denial. If the request is denied, reasons for denial will be provided in the response to the applicant.

Additional Information:

- There is no pre-approved plant or tree list.
- For any questions on the process, submissions, etc... please contact PMR.
- The review process may take a maximum of 45 days. If the homeowner has not received
 a response from PMR within 45 days, the homeowner should contact PMR. No response
 from PMR or ARC does *not* grant approval. Additionally, the homeowner may request
 that the review process be expedited. However, PMR and the ARC are not obligated to
 meet any urgent review times.
